



Technical Large Animal Rescue Courses

Technical large animal rescue is an infrequent, inherently dangerous type of heavy rescue. This class teaches the aspects of large animal rescue to keep responders, bystanders and animal victims as safe as possible. This course teaches animal behavior in emergencies, trailer accidents, moving and extricating recumbent animals utilizing rope and mechanical rescue techniques, and safe euthanasia considerations.

Based on NFPA 1690 Standards for Operations Level Technical Rescue.

Clothing - Attire:

Please wear comfortable clothing that is appropriate for the forecasted weather conditions and the outdoor environment. Open toed shoes, flip flops, or sandals are not allowed during the exercises due to safety considerations. Belts and boots are preferred. During hands-on exercises we will be in the presence of large mannequins and rescue equipment, therefore gloves and an appropriate hard hat or helmet are required. Also consider bringing sunglasses, sunscreen and a hat, etc. for your comfort and protection.
